DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Test complex electronic commercial or custom systems with the aid of procedures or verbal instructions.
- Set-up and operate standard testing devices and record results in tabular or graphic form.
- Complete and inspect product and repair tags to QA standards.
- Assemble hardware on printed circuit boards and complete system builds.
- Load software onto systems.
- Perform minor troubleshooting if board is not functioning properly after assembly of hardware.
- Follow procedures and diagrams in performing engineering change orders as required.
- Solder through hole and surface mount device components on printed circuit boards.
- Desolder electronic components from printed circuit boards.
- Solder and desolder BGA components on printed circuit boards; reball BGA chips.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma or general education degree (GED) required.
- Minimum two year college/technical school degree in electronics required.
- Minimum one year work experience in related field required.
- Must have basic skills in connecting computer equipment.
- Must have the ability to solder and clean printed circuit boards without damaging electronic components.
- Must have ability to properly maintain production and test equipment.
- Physical ability to stand in one place for long periods of time, lift up to 50 lbs, use hands to manipulate small electronic parts.
